

Alumni House Garden Map

For each garden bed (labeled A1 to M2), the map lists the predominant flowers, grasses, and shrubs--using common garden names in alphabetical order. Since there is often more than one common name for a plant, the chosen identifications typically reveal either the gardener's personal preference or the name used by the source when the plant or seed was purchased.

With the exception of a few annuals (and plants treated as annuals–such as dahlias and peacock orchids), all listed plants are perennials and remain in the garden during the winter. Plurals identify instances where a visitor could see more than one variety in that flower bed. For example, the garden has a dozen different kinds of cranesbill, many located in the same flower bed.

The lists are not exhaustive, not all plants will be observable on any given day, this catalog does not identify specific varieties and cultivars, and some garden plants do not appear on this list because their identity has not yet been ascertained.

Flowers and shrubs: Organized by Garden Beds

<u>A1 Bed:</u> Agapanthus, Allium, Bellflower, Boltonia, Buddleia, Buttercup, Catmint, Columbine, Coral Bells, Crocosima, Elderberry, Foam Flower, Ginger, Hosta, Lychnis, Milkweed, Mock Orange, Purple Coneflower, Strawberry (Wild), and English Thyme.

<u>A2:</u> Apple Mint, Chives, Columbine, Daylilies, Elderberry, German Thyme, Greek Oregano, Hollyhocks, Hostas, Iris, Lemon Balm, Mallow, Snakeroot, St. John's Wort, Sunflowers, Viburnum, Weigela, and Yarrow. Annual: Sweet Annie

 $\underline{B:}$ Coreopsis, Cranesbill, Crocus, Joe Pye Weed, Lady's Mantle, Stonecrop, and Yarrow.

<u>C:</u> Alliums, Anemone, Chrysanthemum, Cranesbill, Crocus, Daffodils, Daylilies, Dianthus, Ferns, Gayfeathers, Hostas, Goatsbeard, Grape Hyacinths, Lilies of the Valley, Meadowsweet, Penstemon, Siberian Iris, Spiderwort, Spurge, Stonecrop, and Yarrows. Annuals: Peacock Orchid and Spider Plant

<u>D:</u> Alliums, Asters, Astilbes, Blue-Eyed Grass, Blue Fescue, Daffodils, Dame's Rocket, Daylilies, Dwarf Lilac, Cranesbills, Fountain Grass, Goatsbeard, Hostas, Jerusalem Cross, Joe Pye Weed, Lamb's Ear, Lupine, Michaelmas Daisy, Obedient Plant, Peony, Phlox, Purple Coneflower, Salvias, Scabiosa, Siberian Iris, Speedwell, Stonecrop, Switch Grass, and Tansy.

<u>E Raised Herb Beds</u>: Chives, Jerusalem Cross, Lavender, Little Bluestem, Mint, Rosemary, Rue, Sage, and Thymes. Annuals: Basils, Cilantro, Dill, Marigolds, Nasturtium, Parsley, Tarragon. E Lower Bed: Coreopsis, Cosmos, Dahlias, and Tulips.

<u>F:</u> Anemone, Arbor Vita, Asters, Baptisia, Bee Balm, Black-Eyed Susan, Bleeding Heart, Boltonia, Candy Tuft, Coreopsis, Cranesbills, Daffodils, Daylilies, Feather Reed Grass, Foxgloves, Ginger, Indian Grass, Joe Pye Weed, Obedient Plant, Penstemon, Phloxes, Purple Coneflower, Sedge, Shasta Daisy, Speedwell, Stoke's Asters, Sunflowers, Tansy, Weigela, and Yarrow.

<u>G</u>: Asian Lilies, Blackberry Lily, Bugleweed, Bugloss, Centaurea, Clematis, Columbine, Coral Bells, Cranesbill, Daffodils, Daylilies, Ferns, Forsythia, Hellebores, Hibiscus, Horsetail, Hostas, Hydrangea, Hyacinths, Hyssop, Iris, Joe Pye Weed, Loosestrife, Milkweed, Ox-Eye Daisy, Peonies, Penstemon, Persicaria, Red Twig Dogwood, Russian Sage, Sedge, Shrub Rose, Siberian Iris, Solomon Seal, Switch Grass, Tulips, Verbena, Viburnum, and Wisteria. Annuals: Cosmos, Verbena, Zinnias. <u>G Rain Garden</u>: Astilbes, Gayfeather, Iris, Ironweed, Leopard's Bane, Lobelia (Blue and Cardinal), Meadow Rue, River Oats, Sedge, Siberian Iris, and Turtlehead. <u>H Bed</u>: Asian Lilies, Big Bluestem, Clematis, Centaurea, Coral Bells, Cranesbill, Daffodils, Daylilies, Gazania, Hibiscus, Honeysuckle, Hydrangea, New England Asters, Ox-Eye Daisy, Fountain Grass, Goldenrod, Loosestrife, Penstemon, Potentilla, Red Twig Dogwood, Scabiosa, Sedums, Shrub Rose, Snow-in-Summer, Siberian Iris, Switch Grass, Tulips, Viburnum, and Wisteria. Annuals: Cosmos, Verbena, Zinnias

<u>I</u>: Arbor Vita, Baptisia, Bee Balm, Big Bluestem, Bugleweed, Chrysanthemums, Daffodils, Daylilies, Golden Marguerite, Hollyhock, Hostas, Hyssop, Miscanthus Grass, New England Aster, Peonies, Penstemon, Potentilla, Prairie Smoke, Purple Coneflower, Rose Campion, Russian Sage, Salvias, Sneezeweeds, Solomon Seal, Spiderwort, Stonecrop, Sunflowers, Verbena, and Weigela. Annuals: Lazy Susan Vine, Mexican Sunflowers

<u>J Raised Beds</u>: Columbine, Lupine, Little Bluestem, Miscanthus, Scabiosa, Snapdragon, and Snow-in-Summer. <u>J Lower Bed</u>: Coreopsis, Cosmos, Dahlias, and Tulips.

<u>K</u>: Amsonia Blue Star, Artemisia, Asters, Balloon Flowers, Barren Strawberry, Bugloss, Cranesbill, Daffodils, Daylilies, Hakone Grass, Lamb's Ear, Lungwort, Miscanthus, Moss Phlox, Primrose, Purple Coneflower, Obedient Plant, Penstemon, Purple Love Grass, Red Painted Daisy, Salvias, and Spring Snowflakes.

<u>L</u>: Alliums, Anemone, Balloon Flowers, Catmint, Coreopsis, Daylilies, Dianthus, Gayfeather, Grape Hyacinths, Hollyhock, Penstemon, Purple Coneflower, Rose Bushes, Salvias, Siberian Iris, Spurge, Stonecrops, Toad Lilies, Viburnum, and Yarrows.

Annuals: Love-in-a-Mist and Peacock Orchids

<u>M1</u>: Allium, Asters, Baptisia, Black-Eyed Susan, Bleeding Hearts, Cranesbill, Daffodils, Honeysuckle, Hostas, Joe Pye Weed, Lady's Mantle, Obedient Plants, Peacock Orchids, Peonies, Penstemon, Phloxes, Purple Coneflower, Rose Bushes, Sedum, and Tulips

<u>M2</u>: Baptisia, Blue Fescue, Buttercups, Daffodils, Flowering Crab (Espalier), Hostas, Joe Pye Weed, Purple Coneflower, Rose Bush, Sedum, and Tulips. Annuals: Spider Plants <u>M2 Rock/Crevice Gardens</u>: Bitterroot, Cranesbill, Hen & Chicks, Iris Reticulata, Moss Phloxes, Rock Cress, Sedums, Speedwell, and Thymes
